Heart attack What is a heart attack? • The heart pumps oxygen and blood to all parts of the body. • Blood is supplied to the heart through the coronary arteries (blood vessels). • In heart disease, fatty material (cholesterol) builds up in the coronary arteries, making it more difficult for blood to get through. This is called atherosclerosis.
